Congdon narrates Kennan's legendary foreign service work, his later career with the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton, and the schools of thought to which he made significant contributions: political realism, antidemocratic social and political criticism, Spenglerian gloom, and conservative cultural analysis. 219.
